In 2022, OFCU expanded its field of membership beyond Oxford county to offer service to residents of Androscoggin, Cumberland, Franklin, Kennebec, Knox, Lincoln, Sagadahoc, Somerset and York counties. The Farmington location will be the newest addition to OFCU's branch network since opening a branch in the Oxford Hills area in 2001, reinforcing the Credit Union's mission of guiding its communities in the pursuit of financial security.
